The facility provides rural low income Virginians with adequate, affordable and safe water/sanitation services. Programs include the SE Rural Development Loan Fund established to fill financing gaps in low-income communities with flexible, affordable low-interest loans for water and waste water development activities. Also the Indoor Plumbing and Rehabilitation Program which provides indoor plumbing facilities and rehabilitation of substandard, unsafe housing for low income rural homeowners.

Indoor Plumbing and Rehabilitation Program provides water and wastewater needs, indoor plumbing facilities and rehabilitation of substandard, unsafe housing for low-income, rural homeowners. Seed grants and loans are offered for upgrades, new construction of water/wastewater projects, and for community economic development projects.
