Twenty different floor plans to choose from for apartments and four-floor plans for cottages. The Samaritan Fund is a Benevolent Care Fund offered to residents who have outlived their assets.

Entrance Fees are based on the size of the residence, the number of occupants, and which residency agreement you choose.
