Individuals wishing to utilize the Complementary Paratransit and/or Deviated Fixed Route service are required to complete an ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) [application](#). ADA Complementary Paratransit and Deviated Fixed Route Services are made available to all origins and destinations within a width of $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile of each side of a fixed route. This includes an area within $\frac{3}{4}$ mile radius at the terminus of each fixed route as well. Applications can be obtained via fax, mail, in person, or downloaded. The completed application will include a licensed or certified health care professional attesting to the passenger's disability and that such disability would prevent the passenger from independently using the fixed-route transit or accessing a fixed-route transit bus stop.
