Call for an eligibility assessment. Once determined eligible, call at least two business days before needed ride to make a reservation. Longer notice is preferred. For reservations, call between 8:30 am and 3:00 pm. Medical transportation appointments should be scheduled Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM.
